

 Mission: We aim to bring together local and international communities of children who are being made confident of their ultimate purpose.





How can parents help with homework?

- Reading 20 minutes a day
- Math
- Language
- Occasionally other Homework

WHY READ 20 MINUTES AT HOME?

Student A Reads	Student B Reads	Student C Reads	
20 minutes per day	5 minutes per day	I minute per day	
3,600 minutes per school year	900 minutes per school year	180 minutes per school year	
1,800,000 words per year	282,000 words per year	8,000 words per year	
Scores in the 40th percentile on standardized tests.	Scores in the 50th percentile on standardized tests.	Scores in the 10th percentile on standardized tests.	

If a student starts reading for 20 minutes per night in Kindergarten, by the end of 6th grade, Student A will have read for the equivalent of 60 school days, Student B will have read for 12 school days, and Student C will have read for 3.




Behavior rating of 3's or 4's
